



POSTPONEMENT OF BID
CONTRACT NO. G-TN-R2-7 (R)
(Second Postponement)

Reference is made to the Invitation to Bid, Contract No. G-TN-R2-7 (R) for the Seventh Bangkok Water Supply Improvement Project (Phase II) issued on December 9, 2009, and the Postponement of Bid issued on January 28, 2010

The Metropolitan Waterworks Authority has hereby postponed the date of Bid Receiving and Bid Opening of the said invitation. The Authority is still awaiting the approval from the cabinet about the arbitration procedure for settlement of disputes in bidding documents according to the condition of JICA Loan Agreement.

The new schedule is reset as follows :

1. All bids must be prepared in two separated and sealed envelopes, one contains information for Technical Proposal and another one contains the Cost Proposal in accordance with the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents Volume I and III, and the bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of Baht 34,500,000 and must be delivered in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders on or before 10.00 hours (Bangkok time) on April 29, 2010 at Room 401, 4th floor, Metropolitan Waterworks Authority, Headquarter, 400 Prachachuen Road, Lak-Si District, Bangkok 10210, Thailand.

2. Bid opening will be made in accordance with the procedures stipulated in the Instructions to Bidder and Bidding Document, Volume I. (Part A.) The envelopes containing the information for Technical Proposal will be opened at 10.15 hours (Bangkok time) on April 29, 2010 and will be evaluated based on construction procedure proposal of bidders, conformity to requirements as specified in the Bidding Documents and the other related factors.

3. Only the Cost proposals of those who pass Technical Proposal will be opened at 10.00 hours (Bangkok Time) on June 1, 2010 at V.I.P. Room, 1st floor, Metropolitan Waterworks Authority, Headquarter, 400 Prachachuen Road, Laksi District, Bangkok 10210.

4. The opening of both envelopes will be performed in the presence of the bidders' representative who choose to attend.
